CPN of North Carolina, Inc. is a statewide organization of executives, public servants and professionals involved with design, construction and related firms who serve the construction industry. Members of CPN of North Carolina, Inc. are a network of individuals who are a trusted source for information, advice and services, and who enhance opportunities for improving our industry.

In order to assist in the education of the future leaders of the construction industry and to create an alliance between CPN and the North Carolina institutions that provide construction industry education, the membership of CPN of North Carolina established an annual scholarship award. In 2009, up to three qualified North Carolina students will each receive a one-time \$2000 scholarship award. In addition, the recipient receives a complimentary one-year membership in CPN of North Carolina.

Application and Selection Criteria

For the 2009 CPN Scholarship, candidate must be registered as a full time student at one of the following universities:

- Appalachian State University
 - East Carolina University
 - North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University
 - North Carolina State University
 - UNC-Charlotte
 - UNC-Greensboro
 - Western Carolina
1. Candidate must be enrolled in a curriculum within the individual schools' architecture, engineering, or construction departments.
 2. Candidate must be in good financial standing with the university and financially eligible to receive and accept scholarship funds at the intended value of the donation.
 3. Candidate must hold a minimum cumulative grade point average of B (3.0 or equivalent) and be a rising Junior or Senior.
 4. Candidate should demonstrate a considerable degree of maturity, leadership, self-reliance, self-discipline, and resourcefulness and must be of good character

IMPORTANT: TO COMPLETE THIS APPLICATION YOU MUST

1. Complete and sign the **application form**.
2. Submit a 1-2 page **typed statement** responding to the following questions:
 - a. What is your career goal in the construction industry?
 - b. Why you are interested in a career in the construction industry and what event or series of events has led you to this decision? Where possible, explain how your previous work experiences relate to a construction industry career.
 - c. What has been your most important extracurricular activity? Why has this activity been important to you, and your most important contribution to it?
 - d. Have you utilized your attributes in leadership, self-reliance, discipline and good character in your daily life, work, and school activities? If so how.
3. Send or have sent to the Community Foundation of Greater Greensboro an **official transcript** of your grades.
4. Send **two (2) letters of recommendation from University faculty members**.
5. Send **one (1) letter of recommendation from a member of the private sector** representing the field of architecture, engineering, or construction.

COMPLETE APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED (post-marked or hand delivered) NO LATER THAN April 6, 2009.
